An activity through which people remove/reduce the market risk.

under it, people go for advance buy or sale transactions at a given price.

Short-selling



A kind of speculative activity under which an equity is sold by a person without owning it.

In this respect, the seller is required to cover his position by buying that equity later.

T+1 Settlement



Recently introduced



a settlement system



in the secondary market



of equity

Under it, any transaction of equity is settled within a day (+1) after the day of transaction (T).

denominations (like ₹ 10, ₹ 20 --)



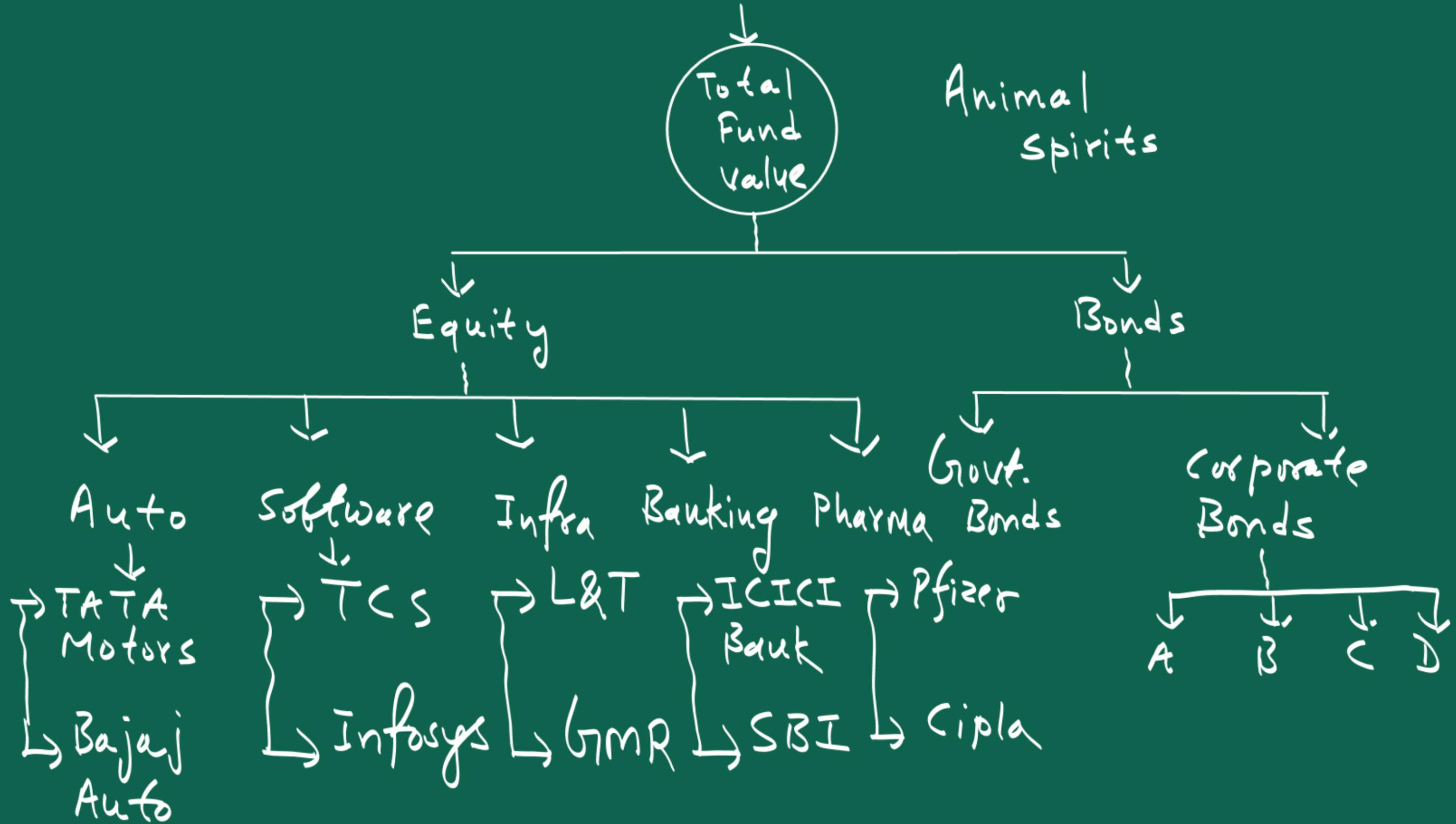

Disinvestment through ETF



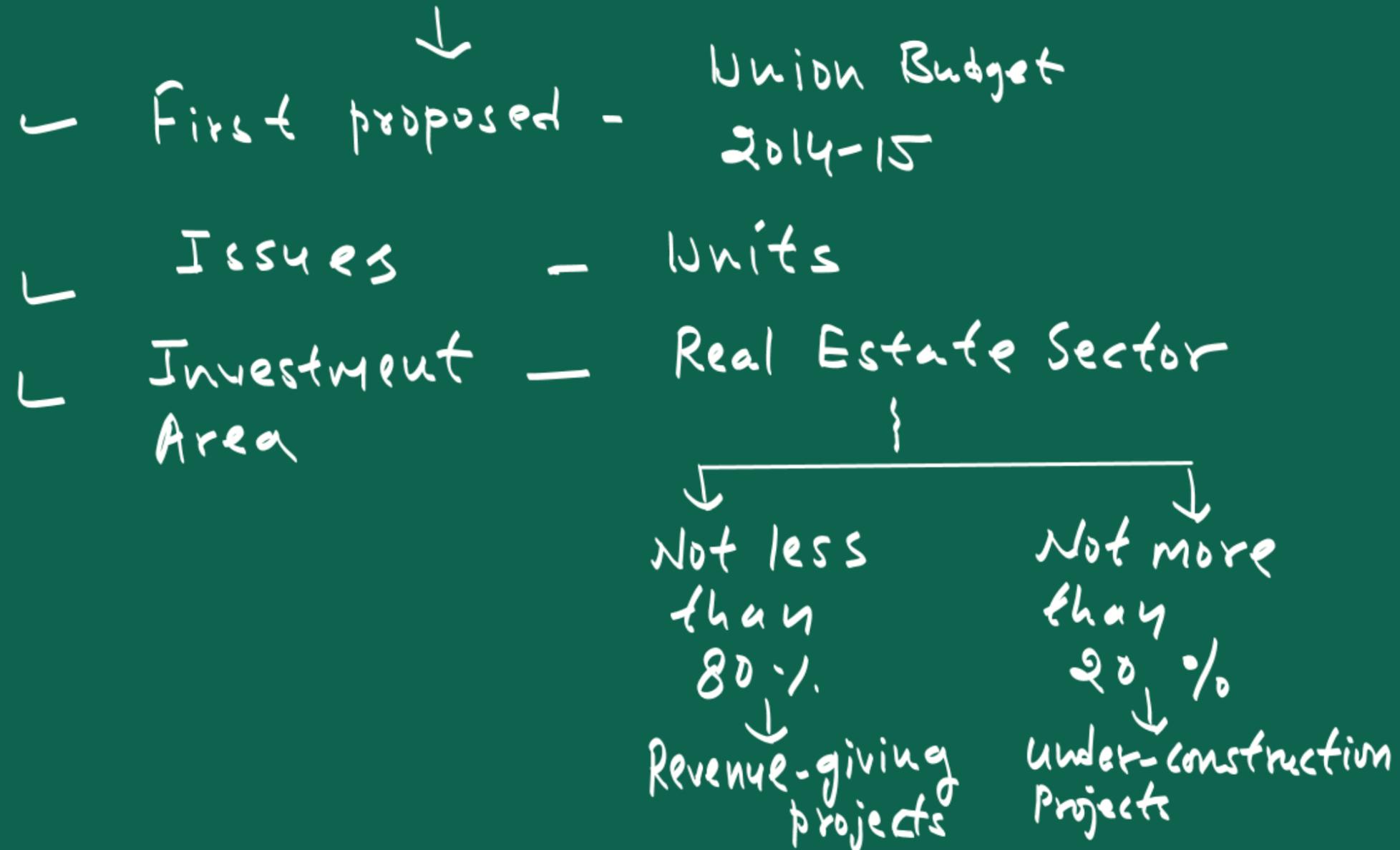
The GOI uses ETF also as a way of disinvestment.
