arbitrary misuse of power.

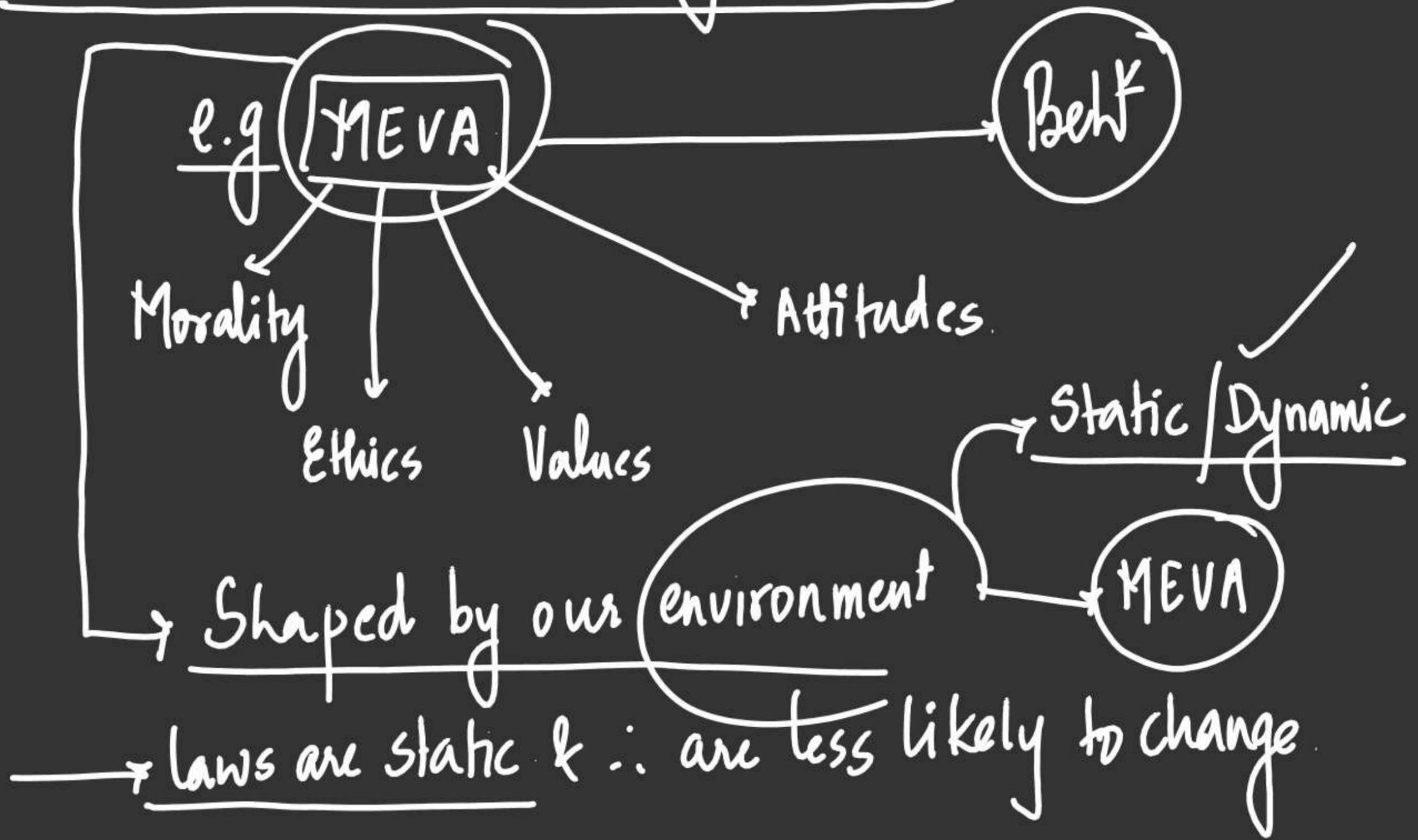
Without any proper reasons.

Laws provide only a moral minimum.

Moral min^m: Laws tells us mostly what should be done, but not what ^{not} should be done.

↑ → moral min

e.g Swami Vivekananda: Non-Individuality

↳ morality: What I do for others, because
When I serve others I serve my self.

Retro-spective amendment

↳ Art 20 : Retrospective amendment
of criminal laws are not allowed.

↳ civil laws can be amended from
a previous date.

Death penalty/capital punishment.

→ Rare of the rarest cases.

→ eg Nisbhaya Case.

How does conscience help in moral actions?

(i) Moral courage:

→ Helps a civil servant
take a moral decision
despite the decision may
not be a populist decision.

e.g. Raja Ram Mohan Roy

→ Against social norms & prohibit

the practise of sati.

→ social reformers.

(ii) Avoiding Group thinking / Challenging

→ Conformity with popular opinion

↳ eg SBA

Toilet in the house was a social Taboo.

→ (a) Ensuring an Ind^v has the capability to take Rational decisions

(iii) holding oneself accountable:

↳ conscience : can allow
an Ind^v/CS to be accountable

↳ CS : Public Money / for the
