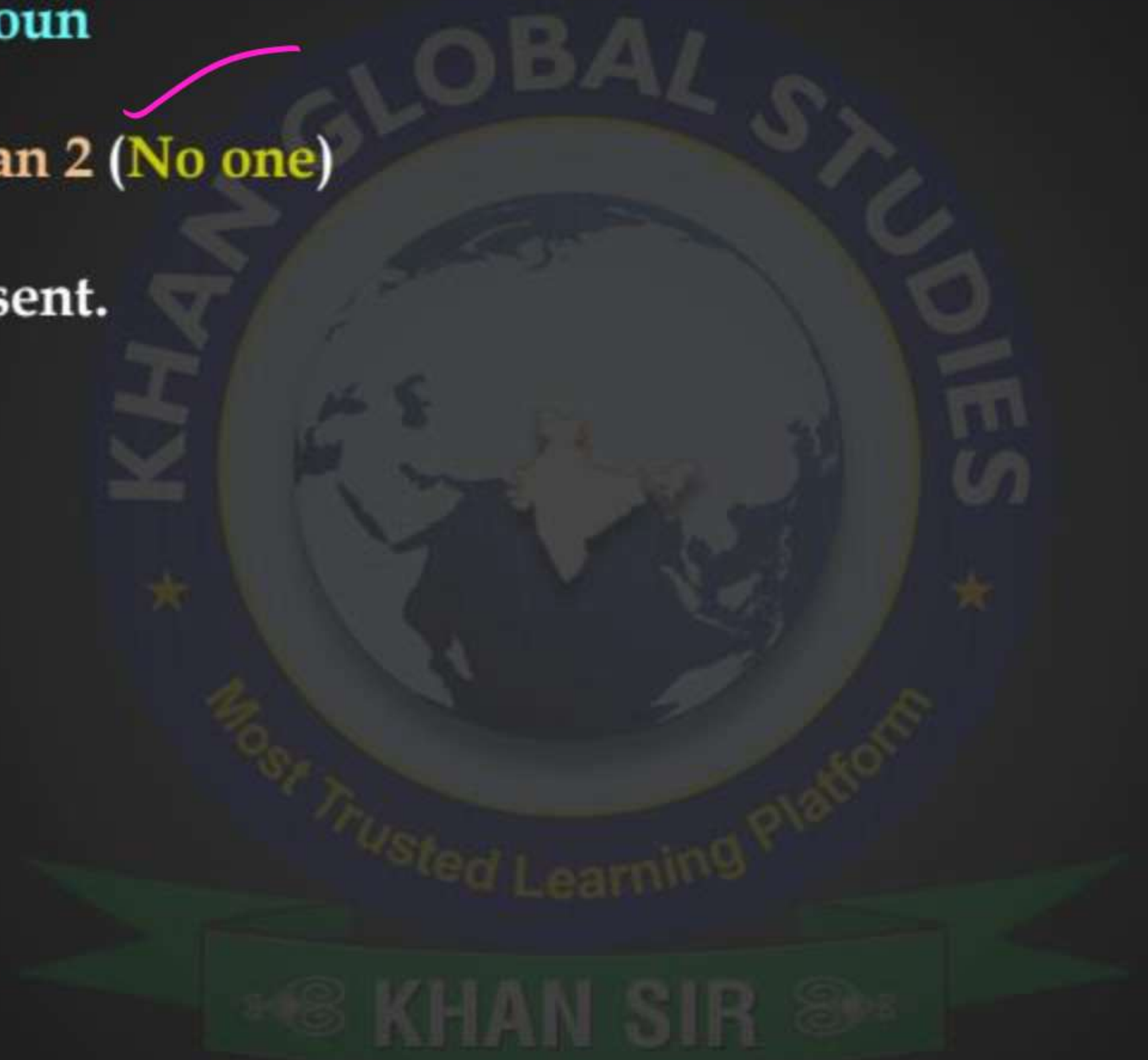

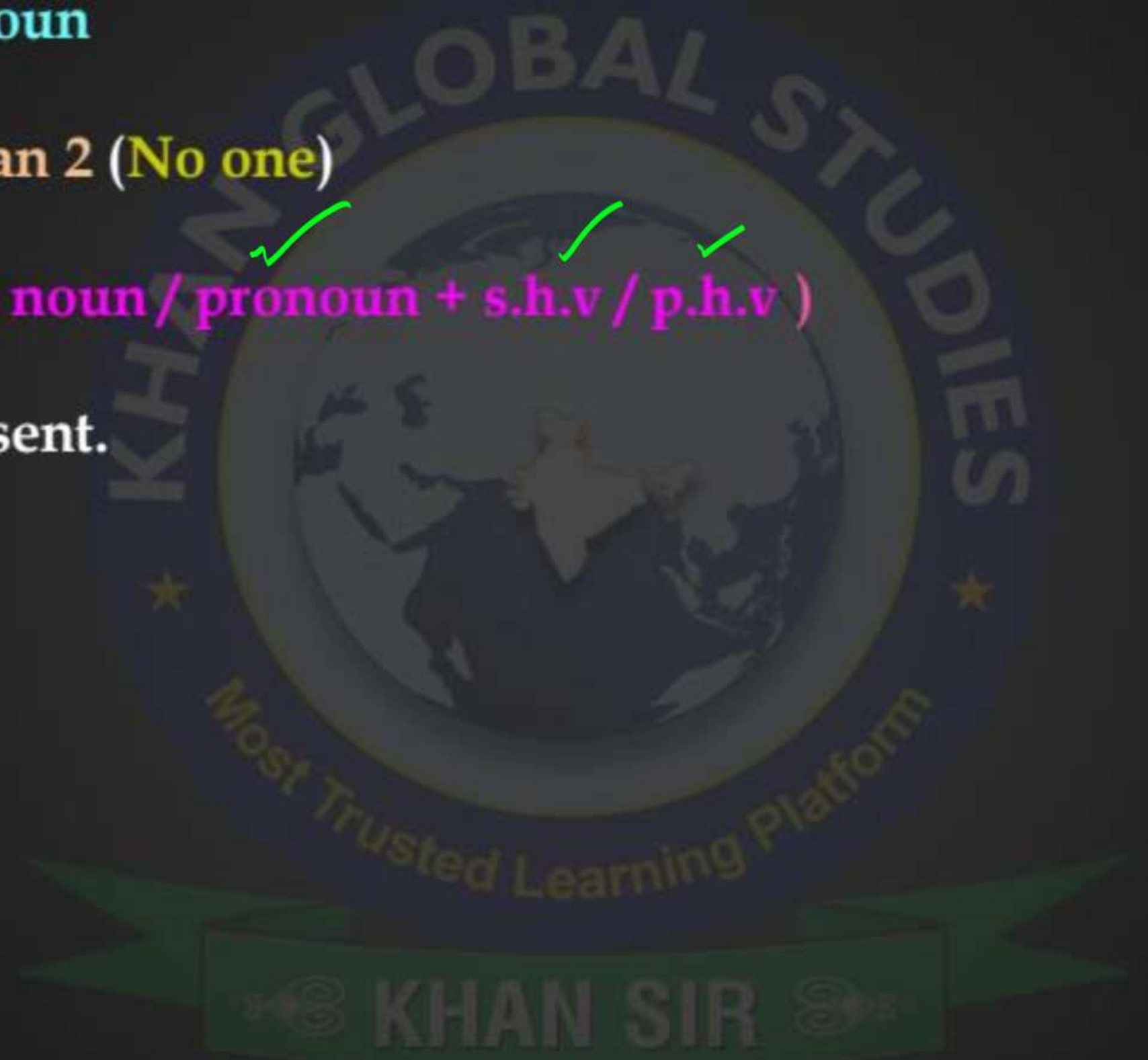

2. None of the boys was/were doing his/their work.

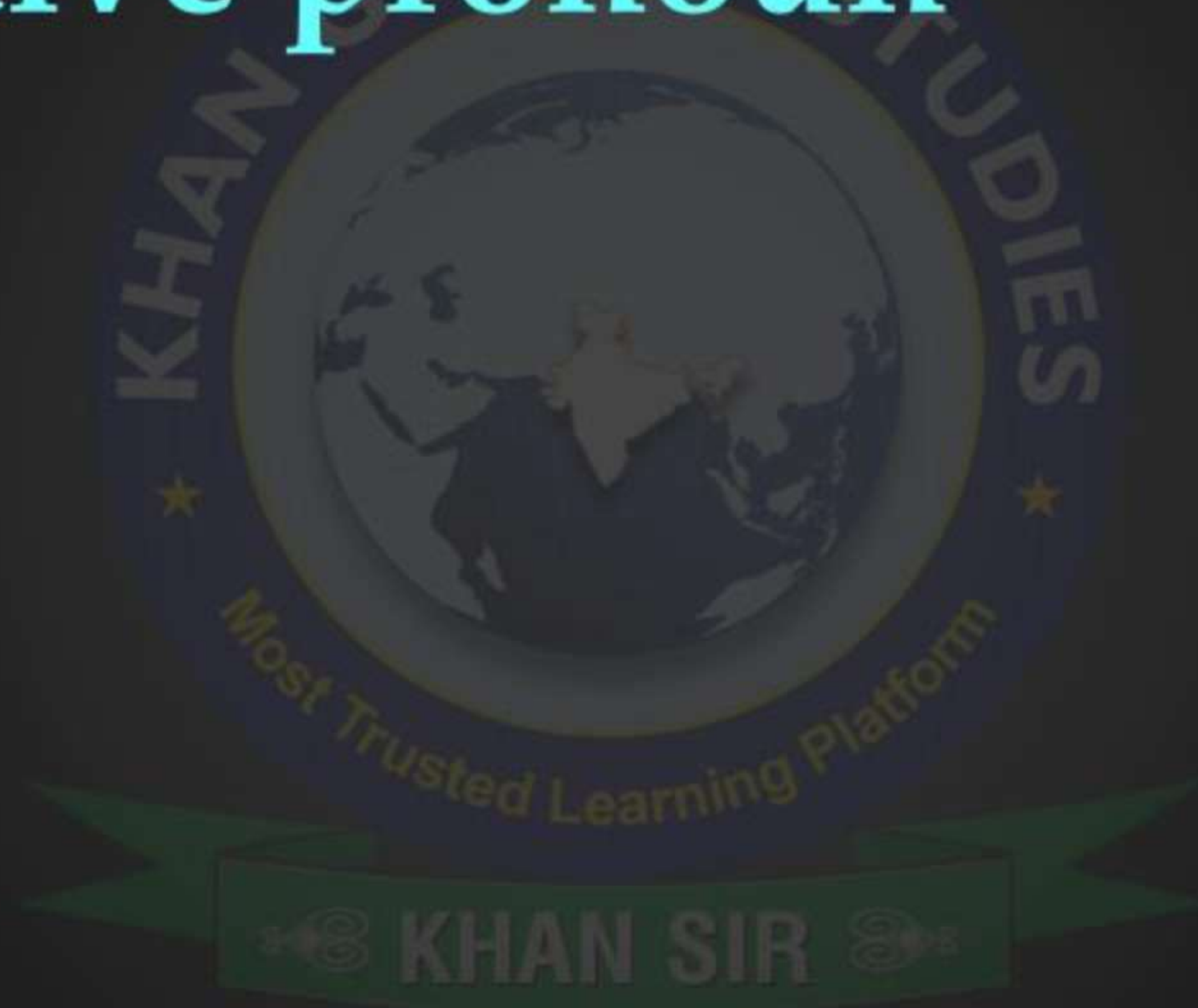

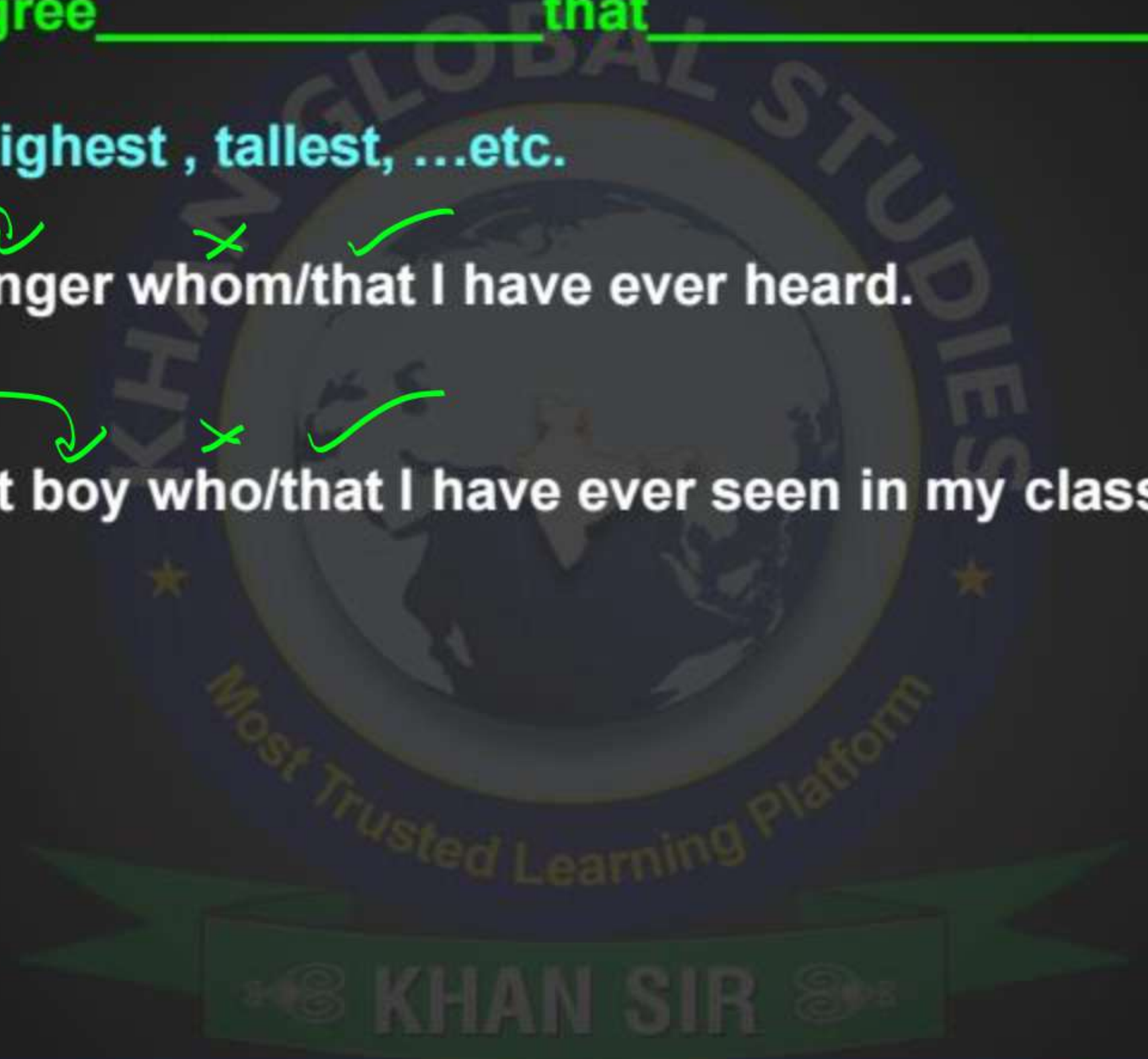


1. Superlative degree \_\_\_\_\_ **that** \_\_\_\_\_.
