Until: This word refers to something continuing up to a specific **time** or event. It emphasizes a duration or the time something will happen or remain true.

Hindi: जब तक.

Unless: This word means "if not" or except on the **condition** that something happens. It indicates a condition that must be met for something else to occur.

Hindi: जब तक नहीं / यदि नहीं.

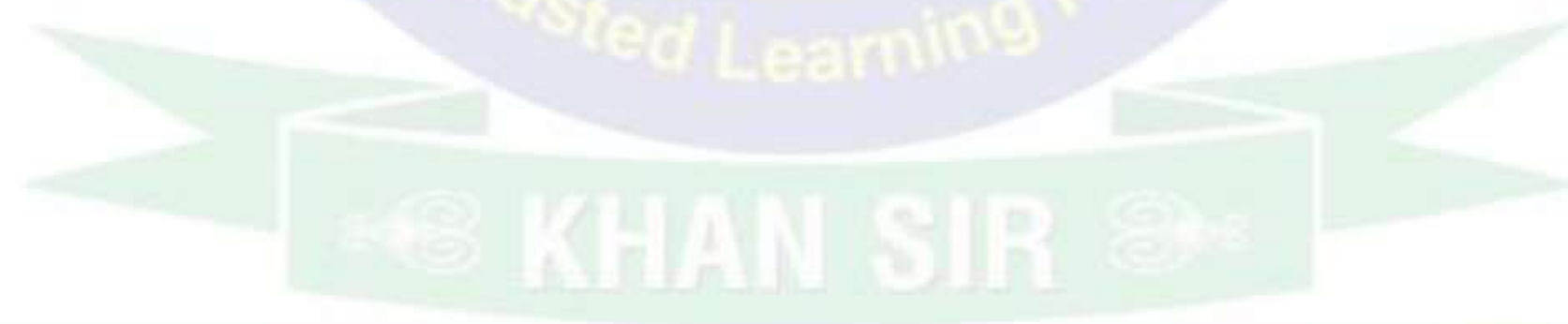


As Long As: This phrase means "while" or "provided that." It refers to the duration or condition under which something will happen or remain true.

Hindi: जब तक / तब तक, जब तक . - Long duration

As Soon As: This phrase means "immediately after" or "once something happens." It refers to the moment an action takes place as quickly as possible after a condition is met.

Hindi: जैसे ही / तुरंत जब . - Short duration
