fell ✓ <sub>1</sub>	felled ✓ <sub>2</sub>	felled = To bring down <sup>✓<sub>3</sub></sup>

raze	razed	razed = to demolish

Lie	lay	lain = To uplift, to collect, to set up upright
Lay	laid	laid = to sacrifice , to keep in a horizontal position, Hens lay eggs






