Negative

Sub + will / shall + not have + v3 + By/From + Time

from Monday

Wh + will / shall + sub + have + v3 + Obj + By/From + Time?

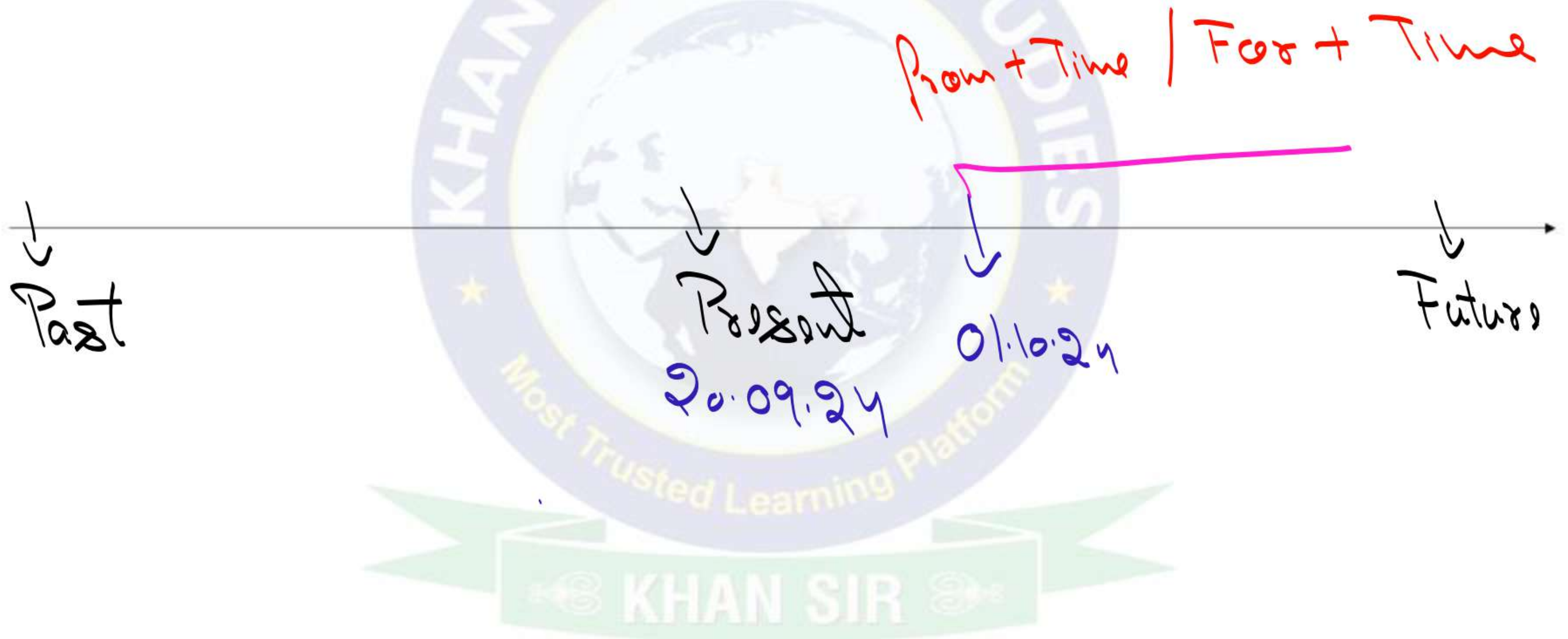
⇒ Will Raju have completed the work by Monday?

Future perfect continuous tense**Positive**

Sub + will / shall + have been + v4 + Obj + from + time + for + time

→ He will have been living in U.S.A from 1st July for 2 years
