

**Wh + will / shall + sub + have + v3 + Obj + By/From + Time?**


⇒ Will Raju have completed the work by Monday?

# Future Perfect continuous tense



## Future perfect continuous tense

## Positive

Sub + will / shall + have been + v4 + Obj + from + time + for + time

→ He will have been living in U.S.A from 1st July for 2 years

## Negative

Sub + will / shall + not have been + v4 + Obj + from + time + for + time



Future perfect continuous tense

Interrogative

Wh + will / shall + sub + have been + v4 + Obj + from + time + for + time?

> Will he have been living in U.S.A from 1st July 2025,  
for 2 years?

Interrogative negative

Wh + will / shall + sub + not have been + v4 + Obj + from + time + for + time?


